# MTC Experience Across the Globe: Southern Sudan

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION



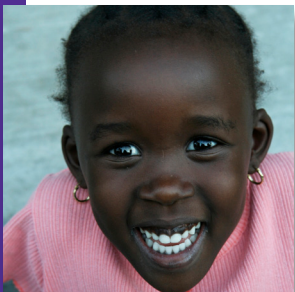
From November 2006 through January 2007, MTC assisted Creative Associates with a UNICEF project in Southern Sudan. In a post-conflict environment, Ministries worked diligently to develop policies and procedures for the new Government of Southern Sudan (GOSS). Creative and MTC worked side-by-side with the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology (MoEST), to develop a framework and system design document that would be the basis for the development of MoEST Vocational Education Policy (Vocational Education Act).

## A FRAMEWORK FOR SUCCESS

The team's work complimented and built upon the Southern Sudan Broad Curriculum Framework (2003) and the Southern Sudan MoEST Policy Handbook (2006). MTC provided vocational expertise, met with multiple national and state Ministries, stakeholders, NGOs, employers and citizens to develop a vocational matrix and policy briefs to guide the new government policies and legislation. The team developed and used a situational analysis questionnaire and created an 87-page document for guidance and development of the vocational system. Stakeholder meetings were held in Juba, Maridi and Rumbek, Sudan. MTC also advised ministry staff on curricula needs and development for several vocations. MTC provided match funds for the project as well.



## LASTING RESULTS



A Policy Framework was developed and approved by the Sudanese legislature. Ministry staff were trained in policy development and processes and the Policy Brief Handbook was provided for further system implementation. Gap Analysis tools and the questionnaire were included for staff use. The vocational matrix of partners, stakeholders, agencies and interviews was completed. Copies of curricula handbooks for 10 vocations were provided.
